Structure

- Concise 18-month general management program with 30 integrated courses
- Every other Friday and Saturday, at Carthage in Kenosha, Wisconsin
- Three one-week residency sessions at Loyola in Chicago
- Ten-day international trip

INVESTMENT

Application Fee: \$100

Classes generally meet on Fridays and Saturdays on alternating weekends. The program allows participants to continue their careers while exploring and becoming proficient in a broad range of functional and managerial skills.
